The Library Project officially kicked off on May 9, 2013 as the Shepherdstown Public Library, in partnership with the Jefferson County Development Authority, Snyder Environmental Services and Triad Engineering, hosted its Brown-Breaking Celebration on site at the soon to be former Shepherdstown municipal dump. In attendance were officials and delegates from the Governor's Office, U.S. and State Senate, Jefferson County, and the Office of the Mayor. Also present were the Library's Board of Trustees, Dan Brinke, representing the Nora Roberts Foundation (whose generous support made land cleanup possible), WVLC Library Development Director John Paul Myrick, Patrick Kirby from the Northern WV Brownfields Assistance Center and many interested local area residents. With the sound of bulldozers working in the background, John Doyle, former delegate and long-time supporter
