## Planning and Zoning Update



The Journal recently reported that under the current Jefferson County Zoning ordinance Appendix C, Principal Permitted Uses Table, a library is not a permitted use in a residential growth area. We are pleased to report that the Jefferson County Commissioners voted unanimously to initiate a text amendment that would allow “Cultural Facilities,” including libraries, as a permitted use in residential growth areas. At a public hearing on July 14, the Planning Commission voted unanimously to approve the amendment to change “Cultural Facilities” from “Not Permitted” to “Permitted” within the residential growth district.


